Proposed Bylaw Amendment ARTICLE IX: Section 10. Financial Audit

Approved by the Board May 3, 2023

ARTICLE IX: Section 10. Financial Audit Assessment

The board will arrange for an audit, a review or an agreed upon procedure of the church's accounting records in even numbered fiscal every three years by an independent, outside professional and will report the results to the Congregation.

Rationale:

Michael A. Veneman, CPA June 30, 2021 from a letter describing a Finance Policy Review: Best practices state that every church should undergo an audit or review of its financial statements by an independent CPA at least every three years. ... I believe that for the current status of the church, a review may be the best option. ... If the church is in agreement, I believe the bylaws could be amended to call for a review every three years. (The cost of an audit for a small or mid-sized church can range from \$7,000 to \$10,000.)

The Board plans to have an audit, a review or an agreed upon procedure of the church's accounting records during the 2023-24 church year.
